Learning Goals
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Understanding the concept of impact and on the importance of multiplying the impact allowing social ventures to be scalable and sustainable.
Background Information
<p>These case examples will allow trainees to be able to identify green and social problems NGOs and social enterprises aim to solve and the impact of their proposed solutions. They will also have the opportunity to express their ideas and points of view, interact and discuss how these social enterprises/NGOs can scale up and still be sustainable.</p>
Duration
60 minutes
Room Organisation
<p>Trainees should work in groups. The members of each group should sit next to each other.</p>
Support material
<p>Paper and pens or pencils.</p>
Instructions
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. First, the trainees watch the videos provided for each example 2. Then, the trainees in groups identify the green/social problem discussed in the videos and the impact of the solution presented. 3. Give 15 minutes time for the groups to answer. 4. Each group has a spokesperson to deliver the outcomes. 5. The trainer comments on the input for some minutes and provides solution slides. 6. Allow some time for discussion.
